Summer Term Topic: Looking After Our World

My Communication – Suggested Activities and Resources:

Listening and Speaking:

Making requests -Have your child practice using photos, symbols, gestures or words to make choices for food/toys throughout the day.

Play Ready, Steady, Go (practicing listening and waiting) – Use a variety of toys (ball, toy car, balloon, etc). Get your child to hold the toy ready to let it go, say "ready ..." and pause and let them wait for you to say 'Go' before they release their toy. Increase the time between when you say the word 'go'.

Shared Attention – Look at items you see together while out in the garden or on a walk. Point to and label things you see. Look for bugs, flowers, animals, birds, stones, sticks etc. (related to our Looking After Our World Topic).

Mark-making activities

Make dots, horizontal, vertical, circular marks using:

- Fingers in shaving foam
- Brush with water on pavement, paper
- Fingers/brush in paint
- Fingers in Gloop (cornflour and water mixture)
- Chalk on pavement
- Pens, pencils, markers on paper
- Fingers in dry sand, rice, couscous, porridge
- Make rubbings of leaves, flowers on paper with crayons, chalk
- Fingers in custard, tomato sauce, jelly
- Fingers in flour, sugar, cornflour

Hand strengthening and Fine Motor Activities

Playdough- pinch, squeeze, squash, roll

- Counting toys, food items, objects in your garden (e.g. flowers, leaves), items while out walking (e.g. trees, cars, houses).

- Finding numbers in the house and while out on walks.
- Ordering numbers (1-5, 1-10, 1-20).
- Sorting toys into colours, big/little, or categories (e.g. cars, people, animals).
