Dear parent/carers,

We hope that you have had a good summer and that you have remained safe and well. You will be aware that there is an expectation from the government for schools and academies to fully reopen in September. You will be or will have had a telephone conversation from your child's class teacher to discuss arrangements for your child along with your views and concerns. These will take place as soon as possible with the expectation that all children will return as soon as possible.

For some of you sending your child back to the academy is a daunting prospect and we understand that and will work with you to alleviate any concerns that you may have. For others this is not so daunting their children have been attending part or full time right through the term and taken part in the summer scheme too. We are also well aware that some more medically vulnerable students have not attended since lockdown, but we have remained in contact with you. Again, you will receive a 'phone call to discuss your child returning to the academy. Whilst this will be as soon as possible, we do need to ensure that specialist equipment and procedures are in place for the safety of all pupils and staff.

In July, we wrote to you outlining how we expect the re-opening of our academy will work. This week, the risk assessment has been reviewed and we remain confident that our plans will enable us to welcome back all our children as safely as possible.
