Our topic this term is Viking Raiders!

We will be learning all about the Vikings.



This half-term, we are exploring our topic through our weekly sensory story 'The Viking Who Liked Icing'.

MY COMMUNICATION



In our weekly reading session, we will be exploring our text using our senses to explore Viking objects, sounds and smells. We will practise our mark making, fine motor skills, letter, word and sentence writing in our Move Draw Write sessions. We have sensory sounds (this term the focus is E L H SH R) or Read, Write, Inc. phonics three times a week- some learners will be exploring blending sounds to read words. We will continue to work on our individual communication targets throughout the school day.

MY PSED



In our PE sessions we will be developing our physical competence through participating in sensory circuits linked to our personal targets. On Tuesday mornings we are going to take it in turns (on a three-week cycle) to access Captain Jack's Play Area, PSHE lessons and Careers lessons. In PSHE sessions this term we will be learning about different IT equipment and devices. We will recap the importance of what we can access online and how we can stay safe when using IT equipment. In our careers sessions we will be exploring the job role of a dentist through role play activities.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING

Our science work will involve everyday materials. We will be investigating materials and how we can change them through fun experiments.

MY CREATIVITY



In my creativity lessons this half-term we are exploring music and drama. Each week learners will explore listening to Viking music and will use different percussion instruments to perform simple Viking songs/music.

We will explore drama and role-play by re-creating Norse myths – Odin creates the world, Freya and the Goblins, Thor and the Giants.
