MY COMMUNICATION



This half-term, we will be exploring our sensory story – Ready Steady Mo which is written by Olympic champion Mo Farah. Some of us will be practising our mark making in our Move, Write, Draw lessons linking it to our key sounds and Olympic movements, the rest of us will be practicing writing key words from the story and making our own sentences. In sensory sounds we will be focusing on the sounds J V Y W and TH and those of in the RWI group will be continuing with our programme. We will continue to work on our individual communication targets throughout the day.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



In our maths sessions this half-term we are exploring time and temperature. This will include linking these areas to everyday life and routines/structures. Our science topic is plants so we will be carrying out an experiment to find out which conditions are best for a plant to grow. Each week we will check how our plants are doing in their different locations around the school.
