Our topic this term is Going For Gold. Where we will be learning about the Olympics and how we can achieve our own goals.



Our key text this half term is – A Journey to Paris by Zoe Clayton

MY COMMUNICATION



During our weekly reading session, we will be exploring our key text – A Journey to Paris using our senses. We will continue to have shared book time at the beginning or end of the day.

Three times a week we will be exploring a different sound – this term our sounds are x, z, ch, qu, ng, and nk. Our mark making and writing will be linked to our story and the Olympics which will focus on developing movement and letter formation. We will continue to work on our individual communication targets throughout the school day.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



During Maths, our core focus will be the four operations. Our application focus will be position and direction. We will spend three weeks on positional language putting objects into the right place. Then three weeks on directional language to complete a task. Our Science sessions we will be exploring the life cycle of a plant, and how the plant starts as a seed and grows into a flower.

MY PSED



Our focus in PSHE will be healthy eating. We will be encouraging our learners to make healthy choices at snack and lunchtimes. Our weekly PE sessions will be class and hall based. Our focus this half term will be developing our bating and ball skills. We will spend two weeks on striking a ball, two week on fielding and finally two weeks combining the two skills. This term in our careers sessions we will continue to look at the role of a

Lollipop person and road safety.

During our Theme days we will get the opportunity to celebrate and explore different festivals/cultures.

MY CREATIVITY



In our Art and Technology lesson our learners will learn about and explore the artist, Pablo Picasso. Each week we will explore a different style of his artwork. The artwork will be linked to different monuments within Paris. During Food Technology we will be adapting recipes to create healthy and balanced muffins. We will be practicing our preparation skills and identifying which ingredients are healthy.

During Music we will explore music and musical instruments from different host countries.
