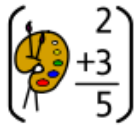


# Curriculum Newsletter

Our topic this term is Going for Gold! We are celebrating the Olympic Games, in preparation for France 2024!



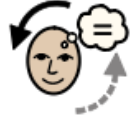
We are reading 'The Burpee Bears', by Joe Wicks, Britain's Favourite PE Teacher!
