

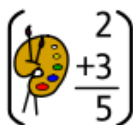

Our topic this term is There's Only One Me, which celebrates who we are as individuals, encouraging us to recognise, identify and name parts of ourselves and our emotions.



This half-term, we are exploring fiction. Our key text is a story called 'The Colour Monster'.

MY COMMUNICATION



During our weekly sensory story session, we will be exploring our text – 'The Colour Monster,' where we will be exploring our emotions linked to the use of colours. Our focus in Sensory Sounds this half term are 'c k u b f' and we will be seeing if we have remembered the sounds and letters. During MDW we will be practising our letter formation and movements linked to our names. We will continue to work on our individual communication targets throughout the school day.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



We will be accessing Mini Maths three times a week and our focus will be number and place value. During our Maths, lesson we will be looking at shapes and their properties. This will include exploring and sorting different shapes, shapes which have straight or curved lines and 2D/3D shapes.

Our Science focus will be Seasonal Changes. Each week we will focus on a different season and compare how it differs from the other ones.

MY PSED



We continue to access the hall for our PE session and this term our focus is dance and gymnastics. During these sessions learners will explore how they can move to different styles and tempo of music. In Careers we will be exploring the job roles linked to the Postal Service. We will also write/make letters and then post them home.

Our focus in RSHE PSHE is about friendships and caring for each other we will access sessions during our FTD on 17th and 31st of January.

MY CREATIVITY



As part of our Music lessons, we will be using body percussion during our PE warm up to identify the different sounds our body's make.

In our Art sessions, we will be creating self portraits using different media for each body part. We will also be learning about Leonardo da Vinci and his portrait artwork.

Our Cooking sessions will be linked to our FTD and our focus will be adapting recipes, Food Safety and Hygiene.

THE WORLD ABOUT ME



We will be focussing on History this term and we will be looking at photographs of ourselves at various ages, We will be comparing how we have changed from being babies to how we look now.

During our Good Afternoon session, we will be counting from one to ten in French, whilst still practicing our greetings including "Hello and Goodbye!"

We will continue to take it in turns to access local walks, including Rufford Park, The Manor Park, The Carrs.
