Our topic this term is Light it Up! Through this topic we will be exploring light and electricity.



This half term, we are exploring fiction. Our key text is a story called 'The Very Lonely Firefly'.

MY COMMUNICATION



During our weekly sensory story sessions, we will be reading our key text - 'The Very Lonely Firefly', where we will be exploring different sources of light and dark through sensory exploration. Our focus in sensory sounds this half term is 'y', 'w', and 'th'. During move draw write we will be practising our letter formation and movements, focusing on different key words from our sensory story. We will continue to work on our individual communication targets throughout the school day.

MY THINKING AND **PROBLEM SOLVING**



In mini maths we will be completing our different individualised activities based on number and place value. During our maths sessions we will be looking at time. Our focus will be looking at days of the week, months of the year and our own individual routines by seeing if we can order these. In science we will be learning about electricity, we will comparing electrical and none electrical toys as well as making our own circuits. All learners will have opportunities to use different technology to help support them during these sessions.

MY PSED



During our careers lesson we will be focusing on the police force. We will be looking at their job role and how they help keep us safe. Our PE sessions are linked to competition. We will focus on different exercises including running, jumping and throwing. We will also be exploring how our bodies change after exercise. During our Friday Theme days, we will cover RE focusing on friendship - the twelve disciples on the 16th of May.


MY CREATIVITY
