This half-term, we will be exploring our key text, through sensory exploration. We will be continuing to practise our mark making in our Move, Paint and Draw lessons. Learners will practice their upper and lowercase writing linked to the phonic sound of the week and words related to the story. In sensory sounds, we will be focusing on the sounds j,v,y,w,and th. We will continue to work on our individual communication targets throughout the school

day.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



In our maths sessions, we will be learning about time linked to days of the week, months and our daily routines etc – being able to identify what we do at different times of the day. We will be practising our individual number targets during our three mini maths sessions. In science, we will be learning about electricity, we will be finding out how electrical items work via electronic toys and switches. Towards the end of the term, we will be making a basic circuit with adult support.
