MY COMMUNICATION



In our weekly reading session, we will be exploring our text **Spinderella**. We will be using all our senses to engage with the story and anticipate what might happen next. Our focus during sensory sounds this half term is W, J, W, TH, and V. We will also be seeing if we can remember the sounds we learned last year. We will be practising mark making and letter formation using different movements Is linked to our story to help us form letters, words and sentences. Throughout the school day, we will continue to work on our individual communication targets.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



In our Maths sessions, our core focus will be number and place value. Our application focus will be time, where we will be ordering events from day and night, as well as sequencing yesterday, today and tomorrow. During our Science lessons, we will be exploring states of matter and investigating what happens when we change the temperature. We will continue to access Computing and Technology throughout our Hello, Science and Maths sessions, using a range of digital tools to support our learning.

MY PSED



During our careers lesson we will be focusing on the police force. We will be looking at their job role and how they help keep us safe.

Our PE sessions are linked to competition. We will focus on different exercises including running, jumping and throwing. We will also be exploring how our bodies change after exercise.

During our Friday Theme days, we will cover RE focusing on friendship – the twelve disciples on the 16th of May.

MY CREATIVITY



This half term, our class will be embarking on a creative journey as we explore textures, colours, and national symbols through hands-on art activities. Each week, we will experiment with different materials while creating collaborative puzzle-piece flags from the host countries of the World Cup. sessions, we will be accessing Music during our morning "Hello" session, where the children will be exploring tempo and rhythm through simple percussion, movement, and listening activities. This will support their creativity, coordination, and early musical understanding throughout the term.
