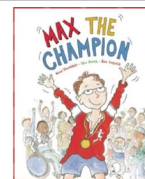
Class: Investigators 2 Term: Summer 1

MY COMMUNICATION



This half term we will be exploring our new story 'Max the Champion'. We will be linking our letter formation, single word and sentence structure to our book to include different words associated with sport and competition. We will continue to stream our phonics sessions.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



In maths we will be looking at time and temperature through multisensory approaches. In science we will introduce the topic of states of matter through an attention autism approach to learn about solids, liquids and gases.

MY PSED



In PSHE, we will be focusing on physically and mentally healthy lifestyles.
In PE, we are taking part in summer athletics, as well as some football in preparation for the World Cup!
In Careers, we will be learning about lifeguards, and in RE our focus is St George.

MY CREATIVITY



This half term, we are learning about Jackson Pollock, who was famous for his "drip painting" technique—splashing and pouring paint onto a canvas.
