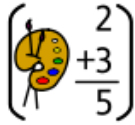


Curriculum Newsletter

MY COMMUNICATION



We're following our topic this term with 'Max the champion'. We will be using inference skills to identify how we think the characters are feeling during the story. During writing we are going to create our own characters for a football story of our own.

Learners will continue to develop their letter formation, identification, decoding and reading skills during their phonics sessions.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



This term, we're using our chemistry knowledge and investigating solids, liquids and gases. We will complete some discovery challenges in a hands on approach and see if we can identify how to make some solids liquids and vice versa.

In maths we will look at Fractions, Ratio and Algebra and applying our measurement time and temperature knowledge.
