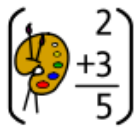


Curriculum Newsletter

Class: Researchers 3 Term: Summer 1



Our topic this half term is 'Football Fever.' We will be learning about the World Cup 2026 and how it is hosted across three countries.



Our key text this half-term is 'Spinderella', written by Julia Donaldson

MY COMMUNICATION

This half-term we are exploring our sensory story is 'Spinderella'.

Through fun, hands-on activities, learners will use all their senses to bring the story to life and build their understanding. In our Language for Life sessions, we are thinking about different foods, helping our learners to hear, feel and recognise each one in lots of different ways. We will continue working on our communication skills using communication boards and flashcards.



MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



In our Maths sessions, we are exploring time and temperature. We will look at using timers and what we do at specific times during the day, and some of us will match these activities to a specific time using a clock face. We are also developing our learners' understanding of number and place value, with activities matched to each child's individual targets. In Science, we are learning about states of matter- we will carry out a range of experiments by freezing and melting different objects.

MY PSED

In PSHE we will be focusing on physically and mentally healthy lifestyles.

In PE we are talking part in summer athletics, plus some football in preparation for the World Cup!

In Careers we will be learning about Lifeguards, and our RE focus is St George.



MY CREATIVITY

This half-term in Art we will be focusing on the three host countries for the World Cup; looking at their flags and then creating our own representations of them using different materials.

In Music we will continue our focus of the three host countries, we will be exploring traditional music from each country and identifying which instruments are most used in their music.



THE WORLD ABOUT ME



We will be focusing on History this half term, we will be exploring how the World Cup and the game of football has changed over the years. We will be looking at what is still the same and what is different.

We will be exploring the names of classroom objects in French.
