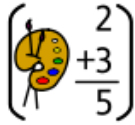

Our Spring 2 topic is

MY COMMUNICATION



- We are reading Frankie's Magic Football by Frank Lampard through a mix of teacher-led, 1:1 and independent reading. Learners will explore a new chapter each week and answer comprehension questions.
- In Writing, we are planning and creating our own stories inspired by the Football World Cup, using our class text. We will explore travel, places and favourite sports to support our ideas.

MY THINKING AND PROBLEM SOLVING



- In Maths, our core focus is fractions, ratio and algebra. We will also develop our understanding of time, including o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to, as well as digital clocks, 24-hour time and am/pm.
- In Science, we are learning about States of Matter, exploring solids, liquids and gases through experiments and the water cycle.
- In Computing, we will continue focusing on online safety.

MY PSED



- In PE, our focus is Athletics and Competition, including a Sports Afternoon on 23rd April.
- In PSHE, we will explore physical health and fitness.
- We will also learn about St George's Day on 24th April.
- Careers work will include enterprise fundraising for Prom and transition visits to Further Education and Day Services.
